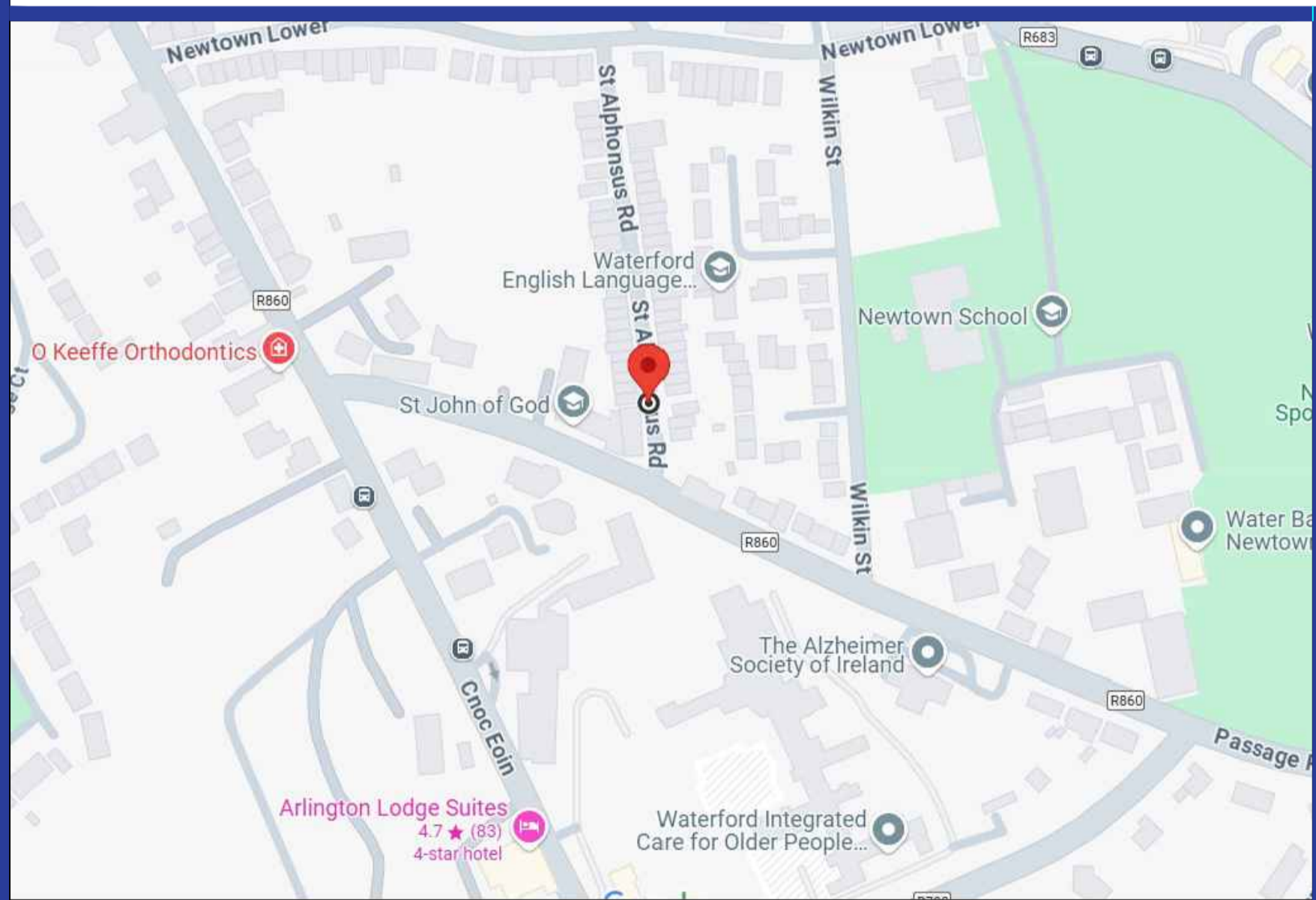


Upgrading current speed bump to a raised pedestrian crossing

Proposed Works

The proposed works included alterations to the existing front of school area on R860. The proposed scheme consists of traffic calming, pedestrian crossing upgrades, buildouts, parking realignment and place-making, including colourful school gateway elements on the R860. The scheme also proposes improved pedestrian crossing on L90365 and junction tightening on the junction of R860 and L1521 (Johns Hill).

As part of the Safe Routes to School programme under Active Travel works in the area, the objective is to prioritise safe access to the school, improve school visibility through signposting and placemaking, and reduce vehicle congestion at the front of school, as set out on the attached drawing.
